



The action was dismissed by the District Court, on or about August 26, 2015. However, the Company timely filed a notice of appeal on September 24, 2015. See *Energy Coal, S.p.A. v. CITGO Petroleum Corp.*, No. 2:14-cv-03092, D.I. 46 (W.D. La. September 24, 2015) (Notice of Appeal).
